## Report from the Finance Committee

Our regular income for this calendar year thru March 31 totaled \$65,910. Our budgeted expenses and obligations thru the same time period were \$65,682 so our income exceeded our expenses by \$228.

Between our budgeted expenses for Mt Zion Missions, Church and Society, and Conference Benevolences plus unbudgeted 'outreach' efforts such as Haiti (\$2,271.60), One Great Hour of Sharing (\$326), and Souper Bowl Sunday (\$334) our total missions/outreach expenditures so far this year is \$11,009 which is 13.9% of our total expenditures thru March 31st.

We began the year with total debt of \$371,317. We've paid \$5,457 for our first quarter interest payment and made principal debt reductions payments of \$6,977 leaving our outstanding loan total at \$364,340. Our debt reduction payments consisted of \$1,300 from our budgeted income plus an additional \$5,677 from donations and other fundraising activities.

Your stewardship is important to the programs and upkeep at Mt Zion. Please prayerfully consider your tithes and offering that support these programs. And consider electronic giving so your offering is received even while you are away during the upcoming summer months. 


